### AFFILIATION

Founded in 1944, Gateway Seminary became an official seminary of the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) in 1950. Gateway Seminary is supported through the Cooperative Program, tithes, offerings, and other gifts from the SBC. Instruction occurs in accordance with the Baptist Faith and Message statement of faith.

## DEGREE PROGRAMS

### MASTER OF DIVINITY

The MDiv is a 90-hour program enabling students to develop as a ministry leader and prepare for a wide variety of vocations.

### MASTER OF THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

The MTS is a 49-hour program designed as an alternative to the MDiv degree for those who desire to deepen their biblical and theological knowledge.

### MASTER OF ARTS IN EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

The MAEL is a 49-hour program that is intended for those interested in the educational ministries of the church and para-church organizations.

### MASTER OF MISSIOLOGY

The MMiss is a 49-hour program that serves to equip, develop, and train students for a competent and biblically contextual ministry in a cross-cultural context.

### MASTER OF ARTS IN INTERCULTURAL STUDIES

The MAIS is a 49-hour program designed for students who intend to work in cross-cultural, multiethnic ministry, or missions contexts.

### MASTER OF ARTS IN CHRISTIAN COUNSELING

The MACC is a 50-hour program that equips church leaders with a high degree of competency in counseling ministries.

### MASTER OF THEOLOGY (ADVANCED)

The ThM is a 24-hour advanced academic degree for students who want to continue academic study beyond the MDiv. Fields of study include Historical/Theological Studies or Biblical Studies.

### DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY

The PhD is a four-year program requiring the completion of 42 hours, including a dissertation. The PhD serves primarily to train students for teaching and research, as well as for scholarly advancement in ministerial practice.

### DOCTOR OF MINISTRY

The DMin is a 29-hour, professional degree focused on developing personal maturity, leadership character, and ministry effectiveness through seminars, mentoring, and ministry projects.

### DIPLOMA/CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Students without a college degree, but who are at least 25 years old, can earn a Diploma in Theology, a Diploma in Educational Leadership, or one of our many certificates.

## TUITION & FEES

### Southern Baptist (SBC) Tuition

- Master level: \$275 per unit
- Online courses: \$275 per unit
- ThM/PhD (full-time): \$2,750 per semester
- ThM/PhD (part-time): \$1,500 per semester
- Doctor of Ministry (total program fee): \$10,800
- Audit fee: \$100 per course

### Non-SBC Tuition

- Master Level: \$495 per unit
- Online Courses: \$355 per unit
- ThM/PhD (full-time): \$5,550 per semester
- ThM/PhD (part-time): \$2,850 per semester
- Doctor of Ministry (total program fee): \$16,100
- Audit Fee: \$100 per course

## FINANCIAL AID
