## Setup:

- Staging set on parking lot directly in front of Connect Church
- Table with Gift Baskets offstage set to stage left
  - Gift Baskets placed on table
  - Volunteer seated at table, handing out baskets and diplomas
  - Secondary volunteer will need to approach cars that line up in front of the booth if the line becomes longer than 2 cars
- 3 phone must be used to livestream the event:
  - ConnectYTH Facebook
  - ConnectYTH Instagram
  - Connect Church Facebook
- We will need signage directing everyone to turn to a specific radio station to hear (if we are able to set up FM Receiver, otherwise we will need a mobile PA system)
- Drive In style parking, facing the staging area

- Graduates will be asked to arrive early to get better parking

## **Diplomas:**

- Must be provided by the student or student's family in advance.
  - Then will be placed in the corresponding gift basket.
